The Bandera County Artists Association cordially invites you to participate in the 30th annual "*Funtier Days*" celebration on Memorial Day weekend (May 29th and 30th 2010) in beautiful Bandera, TX. Bandera has a colorful past and what a better way to celebrate it than promoting the growth of Texas Artists and Craftsmen.

Enclosed is an application for your consideration. We have tried to anticipate every question you may have. Be sure you read the policies and understand them. When everyone knows what to do and where to go, it makes for a better show. To highlight the important information:

- (1) No spikes or spiral tie downs are allowed, only weighted hold-downs
- (2) Closing date on all applications will be **April 25, 2010**
- (3) We will only accept Cashier Checks or Money Orders after April 25, 2010
- (4) You will receive a copy of the map with your designated space highlighted and numbered if your application is received before April 25, 2010. Confirmations will be mailed out after May 1, 2010.
- (5) Applications received after April 25, 2010 will be assigned a space # at the show upon receipt of payment (cashier check or money orders only) for the space(s). Please check in at the vendor information booth #60.

**30th Annual “Funtier Days” Celebration
Saturday & Sunday, May 29 & 30, 2010**

INFORMATION

GROUND: Held in “downtown” Bandera, Texas at the courthouse square.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to individual artists and craftsmen presenting their original works. To maintain the quality and variety of the Arts and Crafts shown the Bandera County Artists (BCAA) reserves the right to reject any display that is not in keeping with the rules for the show.

REGISTRATION: DEADLINE IS APRIL 25, 2010. The registration fee is **\$75.00** per 10x12’ space for the 2-day show. There will be no price limit on your items sold and no commission taken. **The application must be completed in full with your signature, sales tax ID number, health permit if applicable and your check payable to Bandera County Artists Association by April 25, 2010. If applications are received after April 25, 2010 we will only accept a cashier check, money order or cash payable at the show before set-up.**

INFORMATION: There is an extensive sprinkler system in place on the courthouse lawn so no stakes or penetrating tie downs will be allowed. Please bring sandbags or other heavy item to place on your tent poles. **NO SETUP BEFORE 5:00 PM May 28th**.

Please note the following:

1. There is a designated info booth (#60) for the vendors to answer any questions you might have. The booth will be manned as follows:

Friday: May 28 at 5:00 pm - 6:00 pm

Saturday: May 29 at 7:00 am - 6:00 pm

Sunday: May 30 at 10:00 am - 4:00 pm

The times of the show:

Saturday: 8:30 am – 6:00 pm

Sunday: 10:00 am – 4:00 pm

2. You must be set up by 8:30 am Saturday, May 29. No trucks, cars, etc. are permitted in the area after 8:30 am.

3. *We will have after hour security on Friday & Saturday night, but be sure you understand that we (BCAA) will not be responsible for thefts, vandalism, storm damage, etc.*
4. *Please do not break down your booth until after 4:00 pm on Sunday.*
5. *Parking will be located at the Baptist church parking lot behind the courthouse on Saturday only.*
6. *There will be no vendor parking allowed around the courthouse square on Saturday or Sunday. Violators will be towed.*

SPACES: Open spaces only are provided and will be 10' X 12.' You provide your own canopy. If you plan to use a canopy, tent or umbrellas they must be **weighted hold-downs**. Pegs or spikes **ARE NOT** permitted as anchors. Electricity will be available on a strictly limited basis at an additional charge of \$10.00 per receptacle, only to **food vendors** and those **demonstrating** an art or craft. Spaces are limited per food category and will be assigned "first come - first serve", in order of completed application received.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE: Upon receipt of your application with the required tax number, agreement signature, health permit for all food vendors and registration fee you will be assigned your selected space and confirmation will be mailed to you after May 1, 2010. You will receive a copy of the map with your assigned space marked with your space number and its location. If you send your application without the registration fee, tax number, health permit number or the required signature your slot cannot be assigned/guaranteed. **There will be no refunds after April 25, 2010.**

All spaces are subject to approval by the Bandera County Artists Association Event Coordinator.
